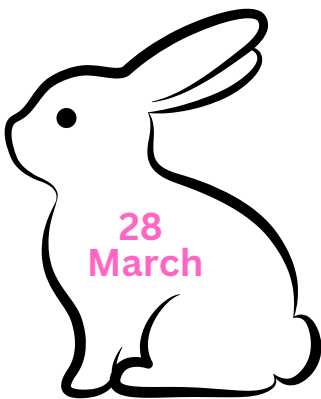
Tregeagle Talks Podcast

Rabbit Run

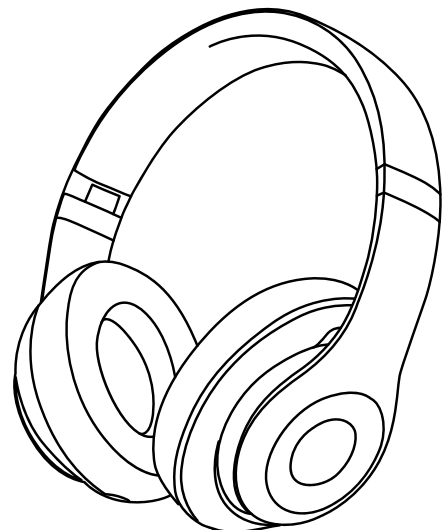
