### Intensive Swimming K-2

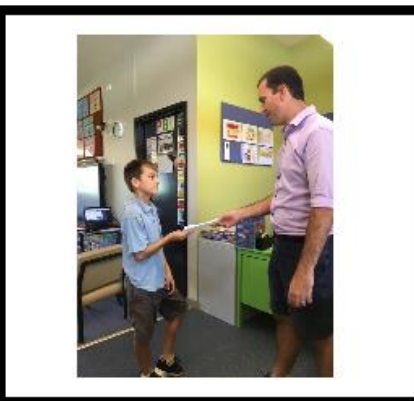
