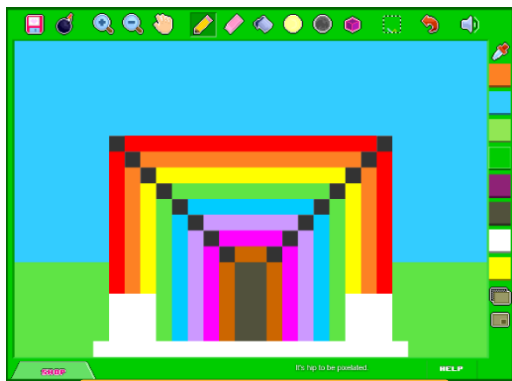
### Attendance Reminder

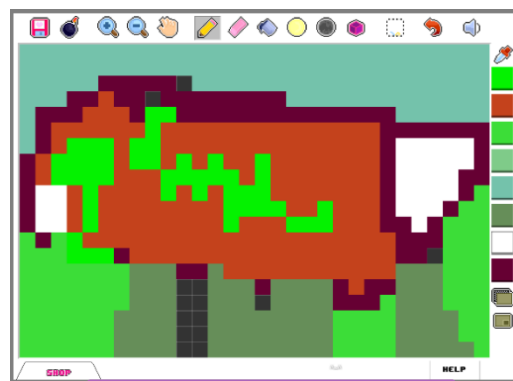
### KS Computers

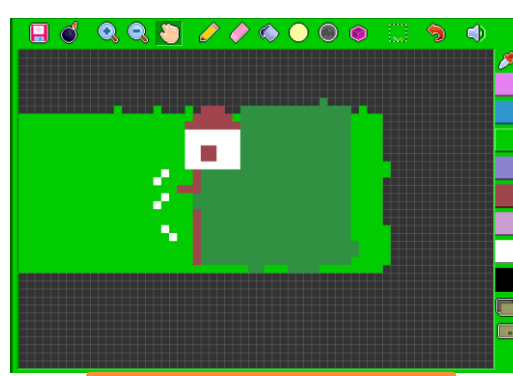

Hollie is playing for North Coast at the PSSA State Championships in Maitland. She has a play off game this afternoon to end her week. She has been playing well as an all rounder.



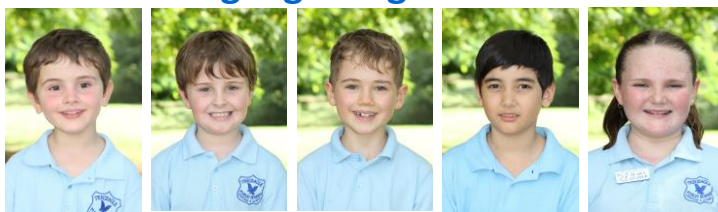
### K – 2 Intensive Swimming – Begins Monday 26 November

- Help your child to brush their teeth until age 8-10. Use a small amount of fluoride toothpaste, encourage children to spit out not rinse.
