Students will know who their teachers are on Day 1 of next year. With anticipated student numbers being larger than normal at +124 (as at today Thursday 13 December) and a continuing flow of in-zone enrolment forms arriving at school (we continue to be unable to accept any out of zone enrolments), it is not possible to provide our students with their class and teacher placements before this time.

Also, if you are a current family at Tregeagle PS and are not planning on returning in 2019 for any reason, please let the school office know to help with planning.

The organisation of classes next year will once again include composite (multi-stage) classes. This is necessary because of the numbers of students we have in each grade and overall classes across our school. Students in composite classes follow the same syllabus as those in straight classes and these are common across most schools in NSW. Teachers at Tregeagle PS work very hard to make sure that each and every student's individual learning and wellbeing needs are considered.

A final reminder that students in Years 1-6 return to school on Wednesday January 30, 2019.

Kindergarten students will begin on Monday 4 February, 2019, with Kindergarten Beststart interviews happening during week one.
