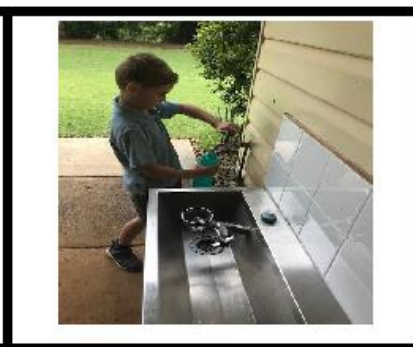

Plants in Action

This term in science, 3/4B students are learning about the different parts of plants and their lifecycle. Students have planted seeds at school and are observing their growth as they begin to sprout. Students will be able to compare the plants we are growing at school with those they took home to attempt to grow.

Along with the potted seeds, each student is observing the lifecycle of a broad bean seed. They have prepared their seeds in a plastic cup lined with paper. They will keep their seeds watered and document the stages of growth the seeds progress through.
