Kindergarten 2019 Information Evening

The Kindergarten 2019 Information Evening will be held next Tuesday 19 June between 6:30 and 7:30pm in the KS classroom. Those families with Kinder aged children for next year are welcome to attend this evening.

Children can start Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn 5 on or before 31 July that year. By law, all children must be in compulsory schooling by their 6th birthday.

When your child starts school is an individual decision. You may wish to discuss this with your child's preschool teacher, carer, doctor or your local primary school. Our teachers are trained to work with your child regardless of their age or level of development.

Children develop at different rates and learn skills in different ways. Our school responds to the needs, learning styles and rates of progress of individual students. It also plans learning experiences based on the skills students bring with them to school.

We believe that children who have a positive start to school are likely to engage and experience ongoing academic and social success.

Afternoon Pick-Ups

Throughout this year, the afternoon duty has been getting longer and longer each day, as a growing number of families fail to collect their children on time. This places unnecessary stress on staff who are then late to their own work and family commitments. School finishes at 3.15pm each day and this is when we encourage families to collect their children. Supervision is provided until 3.45pm at the very latest.
