Lismore Cup – Gazetted Half Day Public Holiday

Going to school every day is a vital part of your child's education. Each missed day is associated with progressively lower achievement in literacy and numeracy. Arriving at school and class on time:

- Ensures that students do not miss out on important learning activities scheduled early in the day
- Helps students learn the importance of punctuality and routine
- Give students time to greet their friends before class
- Reduces classroom disruption

Lateness is recorded as a partial absence and parents/carers must sign child/ren in at the school office. Please remember that all absences must be explained. This can be done via a note, through the School Stream app or a call to the office. Letters will be sent home on a regular basis to follow up any unexplained absences. If your child's absences fall below 85% overall attendance, another letter will be sent home and additional contact may be made to support positive attendance trends, which is in line with Department of Education Policy.
