Attendance Letters

The Department of Education and Tregeagle Public School support the belief that regular school attendance in accordance with the Education Act is important and needs to be complied with.

Our school regularly reviews student attendance. It is our aim to contact families where a student's average attendance rate is below 85%. We understand that there are times when student absences are justified and cannot be avoided. If your child's absences are explained due to illness, a medical certificate may be required. This week, we sent home routine letters to families whose child's attendance was below 85%. The purpose of this letter is to bring your child's attendance rate to your attention so that moving forward we can work together to hopefully build this attendance rate.
