Learning Success

A huge congratulations to our students from Kindergarten all the way through to Year 6 who are showing impressive growth in their end of year assessments, particularly in reading and mathematics. In the recent 'Reading Check In Assessments', Year 5 increased growth above the state average from 2021 to 2022 by 3% (2021: School 64%, State 60% compared to 2022: School 58% state 51%). Furthermore Year 4 Check-in Reading Assessments also pleasingly indicated that the school achieved 2% above stage average. A big thank you to all parents who support homework and home reading so regularly. This extra support really helps students to consolidate their learning.

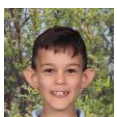
